Roy Cypher: Vietnam War Medic

Served with the 196th Infantry, Americal Division in 1969

Memoir Highlights Sacrifice

Shares emotional and physical challenges faced by medics

Mission of Healing and Honor

Advocates for recognition of medics' heroism and support for veterans



Becoming a Vietnam War Medic

From Civilian to Combat Medic

Roy Cypher faced a dramatic shift from everyday life to military training.

Facing Fear and Uncertainty

Initial deployment brought anxiety and apprehension about the unknown.

Journey to Vietnam

Cypher's trip included an emergency landing on Wake Island, marking the start of his war experience.



Life in Da Nang and Tourane Bay

Arrival of U.S. Forces in Da Nang

First U.S. combat troops landed March 8, 1965.

Da Nang's Bustling Atmosphere

City mixed cultures, vibrant markets, and constant activity.

Daily Life for Soldiers

Soldiers faced threats from Viet Cong and adapted to war zone.


Economic Impact of American Presence

Inflation raised prices for goods and services in Da Nang.

Escalation of Conflict

Viet Cong increased attacks, leading to guerrilla warfare.

Medical Aid in War Zones



Adapting to Shipboard Life

- Cramped, hot conditions and constant discomfort.
- Hospital destroyed, forcing medics to live and work on ships.



Providing Medical Aid Under Fire

- First aid and medical assistance delivered amid threats.
- Medics faced danger from enemy attacks and munitions.



Mutiny and Munitions Ship Risks

- Crew mutiny on the Sheila due to safety fears.
- Constant risk of explosion aboard munitions ships.

Modern surgical tools used in a dangerous, frontline setting.



Casualty Management & Triage

Rapid decisions made for incoming wounded during intense combat.
